

How can I help enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities?

Therapeutic riding benefits the bodies, minds and spirits of our riders. Students are charged less than half the actual cost of a lesson. The remainder of the lesson cost is generated through donations.



How donations are used:

- \$35 – grain for one horse for one month
- \$55 – portion of one therapeutic riding lesson not covered by rider fee
- \$100 – new shoes for one horse (horses need new shoes about 8 times a year)
- \$250 – hay, shavings and manure removal for one horse for one month
- \$500 – partial board for one horse for one month
- \$1,000 – supports one rider for 20 lessons

Horse Sponsorship:

\$5000 – will support one of Simple Changes’ wonderful horses for a year. The adopter receives a personalized Certificate of Appreciation, including a photo of the horse, and the adopter’s name is placed on the horse’s stall. The adopter is also recognized in published materials and on our website.
